Dr. George Owusu Essegbey is a Chief Research Scientist of the Council of Science and Industrial Research (CSIR), Ghana. Dr. Essegbey has served various national and international organisations with his expertise including FAO, UNESCO, UNCTAD, UNEP and the World Bank. He has co-authored scholarly materials in STI policy.
